Before installing Chrome:

MAKE SURE THAT YOUR COMPUTER MEET THE SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

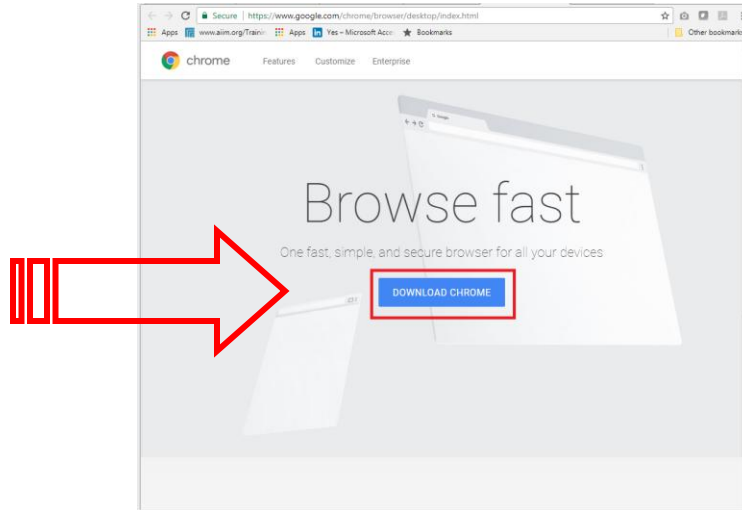

Installing Chrome

1. Visit [this Chrome download page](#) in any browser, such as Microsoft Internet Explorer.



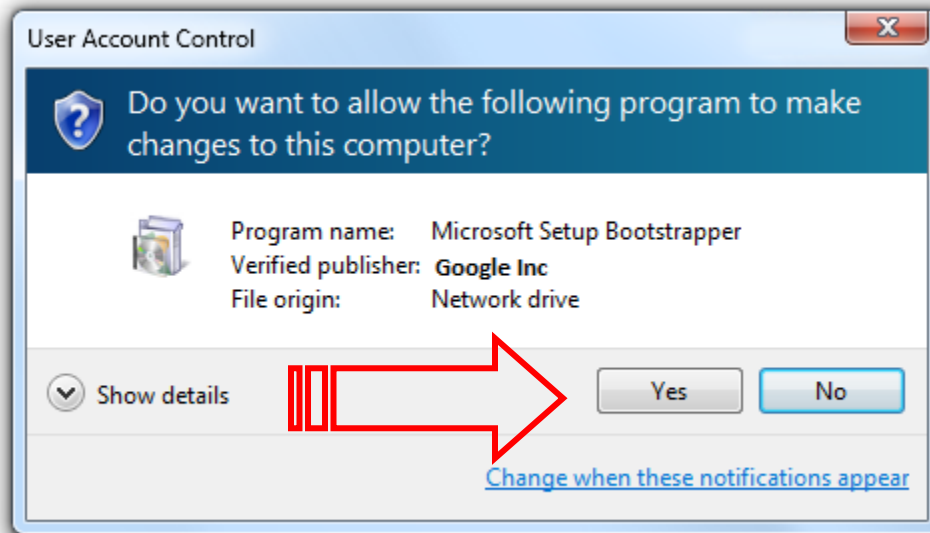
2. Click on the "DOWNLOAD CHROME" button to download the installation file. The page will automatically recommend the best version of Chrome for you.

Note: Only if you use Microsoft Internet Explorer, a notification bar will appear at the bottom of the page with the options to run the installer or save the file to your computer. Click "Run" to start the process.

3. Then, read and accept Terms of Service
